

Gotherington Parish Plan Questionnaire 2013

NOTES

Survey date: July, 2013

Survey type: One questionnaire per household

Response: 238 questionnaires were completed, 21 of these were completed online.

REPORTS

Two reports are provided in questionnaire format:

- Report **A** shows the number of households who ticked each box
- Report **B** shows the percentages

N.B. For some questions the numbers may be more useful than the percentages e.g. A1

PERCENTAGES

- All percentages in Report B are out of 238, which is the total number of questionnaires completed.
- Worked example: In A2 in Report A, 38 households said they have lived in Gotherington for 0-4 years. 38 divided by 238 is 16%, which is the figure displayed in Report B.

Please note that all percentages in the report are rounded to whole numbers.

QUESTION TYPES

There are four types of question in the survey:

1. Questions designed to receive one answer only (e.g. A2)

For these types of questions, the answers will add to exactly 238 (100%*) if all households have answered the question. If any households have left the question blank, the answers will add to less than 100%. For example, the answers to question A2 add to 234 (98%) because 4 households (2%) did not reply.

2. Questions designed to receive more than one answer (e.g. B2)

The answers would not be expected to add to exactly 238 (100%) except by chance. For some questions the total is more than 100% while in other cases it is less than 100%.

3. Grid questions designed to receive one answer per row (e.g. C1)

The answers in each row will add to exactly 238 (100%*) if all households have ticked a box in that row. If any households have left the row blank, the answers will add to less than 100%. For example, the answers in the first row of C1 (Bus) add to 97% because 3% did not reply.

4. Questions requiring a written response (e.g. G10)

The answers to this type of question are not included in the data reports.

**Please note that some totals may add to 99% or 101% due to rounding.*

AGE GROUPS (A1)

- The answers to A1 do not indicate the total number of people in any given age group; rather they indicate the number of households which contain someone in that age group. For example, 5 households (2%) contain two people aged 0-4.
